



Care and Limitations

For Mobitech service engineers or sales people visiting our customer's sites.

Hi-visibility coats/waistcoats or overalls and safety boots are the absolute minimum and must be worn. For our service engineers, any further PPE, relative to the work they are carrying out on equipment at our customer's sites, should also be worn.

Should you ever be in the situation that you find yourself without the PPE you need to do the job safely. Report this immediately to Steven Baker your service manager and don't progress the job any further until the correct, suitable PPE is available for you to use.

You may on occasion visit customers of Mobitech Lift Trucks that have their own requirements regarding the wearing of PPE. We would normally be forewarned of this, but if it arises during a customer site induction and our customer cannot provide you with:

- suitable additional PPE,
- that is compatible with your own Mobitech issue PPE,
- and fits you correctly,

you are to report to Steven Baker, your service manager and he will reschedule the work until such time that we have the correct PPE available.

N:B Should anyone have the distinct misfortune to sustain an injury whilst working for Mobitech Lift Trucks, and they are not wearing the correct PPE, it may also put at risk any type of insurance claim.
