MOBITECH LIFT TRUCKS RESPONSIBILITIES.

Mobitech Lift Trucks will provide PPE for each of its employee's individual needs and PPE requirements.

Mobitech Lift Trucks PPE policy is flexible enough to accommodate individual needs, for example someone with an allergy to latex or pre-existing medical conditions etc.

PPE should be used when all other measures are inadequate to control exposure. It protects only the wearer, while being worn. If it fails, PPE offers no protection at all.

Practical training in the correct fit and use should include:

Each Mobitech Lift Trucks employee will receive training and instruction in the correct use and fitting of the PPE.

This will be carried out by an External Online Training course.

Each Employee will:

- (a) Practice in putting on, wearing and removing the equipment safely;
- (b) Practice in inspection and, where appropriate, testing of the PPE before use;
- (c) Practice in how to maintain the PPE, to the extent this should be done by the user, such as cleaning and the replacement of certain components;
- (d) Instruction in the safe storage of equipment.

The extent of the training that is given will depend on the type of equipment, how frequently it is used and the needs of the people being trained.

As well as initial training, users of PPE and others involved with the equipment may need refresher training from time to time. Records of training details will be kept by Mobitech Lift Trucks to help with the efficient administration of the training programme.
